Reflection

Our forgiveness should be limitless, just as God's love & forgiveness is for us. Jesus' reply to Peter's question "How many times should I forgive?" His parable shows a circle of forgiveness: we forgive others because God has forgiven us, & as we forgive others, so God forgives us. Later, Paul urges the Christians to respect the opinions of others, & leave the judgement to God. We see the destruction of relationships caused by failure to forgive, & we pray for their healing, love & respect.
